## THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS' OF PRECISE BIOMETRICS AB (PUBL) PROPOSAL ON AMENDMENT OF THE ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

According to Chapter 7, Section 4 of the Swedish Companies Act, the Board of Directors may collect proxies for the general meeting if provided for in the Articles of Association. According to Chapter 7, Section 4 a of the Swedish Companies Act it may also be provided for in the Articles of Association that the Board of Directors may decide that the shareholders shall be able to exercise their voting rights by post before the general meeting.

In order to be able to use the alternatives provided by the Swedish Companies Act with regard to decisions on proxy collection and postal voting at general meetings, the Board of Directors proposes that a new article 12 is included in the Articles of Association, with the wording set out below, and that the Articles of Association be re-numbered so that the current article 12 becomes article 13 and the current article 13 becomes article 14.

## Proposed wording

§ 12 The Board of Directors may collect proxies pursuant to the procedure stated in Chapter 7, Section 4, second paragraph of the Swedish Companies Act (2005:551).

The Board of Directors may decide before a general meeting that the shareholders shall be able to exercise their voting rights by post before the general meeting pursuant to the procedure stated in Chapter 7, Section 4 a of the Swedish Companies Act (2005:551).

## **Authorisation**

The Board of Directors proposes that the CEO shall be authorised to make the minor editorial amendments to the above proposal that could be deemed necessary in relation to the registration with the Swedish Companies Registration Office.

## **Voting majority**

The resolution of the meeting regarding amendment of the Articles of Association is subject to the support of shareholders representing at least two-thirds of both the number of votes cast and the shares represented at the meeting in order to be valid.
